9. **School Budget Vote 2011-2012**

Upon the recommendation of the Superintendent of Schools, and on motion by Mrs. Turkington, seconded by Mr. Hogan and carried 3-0 (Mr. Finnegan and Mr. Vitale abstained), the Board of Education voted to accept the results of the May 17, 2011, Board of Education budget vote and election and:

Proposition #1: 2011-2012 district budget in the amount of \$36,704,388 approved 968 to 539.

Proposition #2: 2011-2012 transportation approved 794 to 688.

Daniel Finnegan elected to the Board of Education, term to run July 1, 2011 through June 30, 2014;
and

Wayne A. Vitale elected to the Board of Education, term to run July 1, 2011, through June 30, 2014.

10. **Student Trip**

Identification and Register of Children with Disabilities [Child Find] (Policy #7650) – no CM policy;
and
Parent Involvement for Children with Disabilities (Policy #7660) – replaces old policy IGBA.

On motion by Mrs. Turkington, seconded by Mr. Vitale and carried 5-0, the Board of Education voted to go into Executive Session at 8:27 p.m.
