

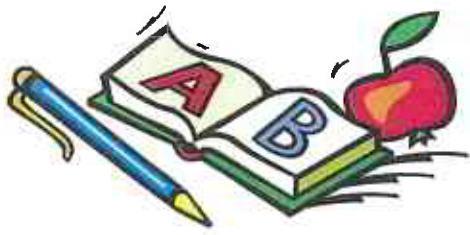

Welcome to our class! I am looking forward to an enjoyable year together. This is so exciting that we get to meet one another before our summer break!

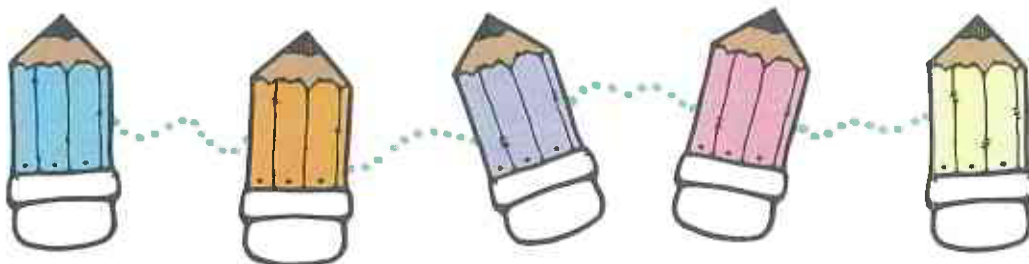
