17. **Transportation – Proposition #2**

RECOMMENDED ACTION: that upon the recommendation of the Superintendent of Schools, the Board of Education of the Center Moriches Union Free School District is authorized to place on the ballot for the May 15, 2012 annual vote the following proposition:

Shall the following resolution be adopted:

RESOLVED, that the Board of Education of the Center Moriches Union Free School District is hereby authorized and required to <u>continue to provide unlimited transportation</u> for the 2012-2013 school year to all students.

17. <u>Transportation – Proposition #2</u> (continued)

A vote of "yes" on this proposition means that the transportation guidelines shall continue as currently provided and will be as follows:

• Transportation will be provided to all students for the 2012-2013 school year.

A vote of "no" on this proposition means that for the 2012-2013 school year, transportation will only be provided as required by State mandates, and shall be as follows:

- Transportation will be provided for students in Grades K 8 residing more than 2 miles but not more than 15 miles from their school; and
- Transportation will be provided for students in Grades 9 12 residing more than 3 miles but not more than 15 miles from their school.

If the "no" vote prevails, the estimated annual savings in transportation costs to the District after the allotment of State aid is \$322,800.

PROGRAM SECTION

18. <u>Student Trips</u>

RECOMMENDED ACTION: that upon the recommendation of the Superintendent of Schools, the Board of Education approves approximately 112 students (Grade 3 – Africa and Animal Study), accompanied by approximately 90 adults, to travel to the Bronx Zoo on June 5, 2012. The approximate cost to each student will be \$39. There is no cost to the district.

RECOMMENDED ACTION: that upon the recommendation of the Superintendent of Schools, the Board of Education approves approximately 140 students (Grade 5 – Liberty Science Center), accompanied by approximately 28 adults, to travel to Jersey City, New Jersey on June 14, 2012. The approximate cost to each student will be \$40. There is no cost to the district.

19. <u>CPSE/CSE – Recommendations</u>

RECOMMENDED ACTION: that upon the recommendation of the Superintendent of Schools, the Board of Education approves the recommendations of the Committees on Special Education and Preschool Special Education for the months of December 2011, January 2012, and February 2012.
