15. Student Trips

Upon the recommendation of the Superintendent of Schools, and on motion by Mrs. Turkington, seconded by Mr. Finnegan and carried 5-0, the Board of Education voted to approve approximately 50 students (Jazz Ensemble & Vocal Jazz), accompanied by approximately 6 adults, to travel to Hershey, Pennsylvania (Music in the Parks) on May 11, 2012 through May 12, 2012. The approximate cost to each student will be \$200. There will be no cost to the district for this trip.

Upon the recommendation of the Superintendent of Schools, and on motion by Mrs. Turkington, seconded by Mr. Finnegan and carried 5-0, the Board of Education voted to approve approximately 70 students (Grade 10 Social Studies), accompanied by approximately 7 adults, to travel to the Museum of Jewish Heritage in Battery Park, New York. The approximate cost to each student will be \$12. There will be no cost to the district for this trip.
